Term 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introductions • Personal Information • Months/birthdays • Physical descriptions • Countries • Weather 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Questions and answers; simple dialogues; ordering and structuring conversations • Using the first and third person to describe self and others • Adjectival agreement • Recognising and using important verbs: <i>llamarse, tener, ser, vivir...</i> • Spanish pronunciation and spelling • Writing and giving a presentation in Spanish • Identifying and learning names for countries • Using a range of weather related verbs in the present tense
Term 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weather (continued) • Snack bar; food and drink • Semana Santa - Easter in Spanish speaking countries 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reviewing and evaluating weather report videos; giving feedback; identifying areas for self improvement; target setting • Using the Spanish words for 'the' and 'a/an/some'; making plurals; learning about masculine and feminine • Identifying parts of speech • Role play skills: using props, listening for cues, learning lines (all in Spanish) • Responding spontaneously to verbal cues • Understanding the culture of Spanish speaking countries through festivals and celebrations
Term 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clothes/Clothes shopping • Friends (descriptions) • Review of the year 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using plurals, adjectives and intensifiers to describe clothing and people in terms of appearance and personality • Using clues to understand new words and phrases; spotting grammatical patterns • Scripting and delivering a fashion show in Spanish • Problem solving in role play situations in Spanish • Manipulating verbs from the infinitive to the first person to the third person • Talking about likes and dislikes; giving opinions with justifications
