Term 2	<ul> <li>School continued</li> <li>Days of the week and schedules</li> <li>Free time activities</li> <li>Semana Santa - Easter in Spanish speaking countries</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Using the Spanish words for 'the' and 'a/an/some'; making plurals; correct use of masculine and feminine</li> <li>Identifying parts of speech</li> <li>Using the Spanish forms of 'he/she' and verbs in the third person to describe the activities others do, and to talk about their schedules.</li> <li>Surveying, investigating and presenting data in Spanish</li> <li>Understanding the culture of Spanish speaking countries through festivals and celebrations</li> </ul>
Term 3	<ul> <li>Food and         restaurants; healthy         living</li> <li>Study of a Spanish         speaking country</li> <li>Review of the year</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Reading, creating and ordering from a Spanish menu</li> <li>Role play skills: using props, listening for cues, learning lines (all in Spanish)</li> <li>Scripting and performing a restaurant role play with variable and spontaneous elements</li> <li>Using adjectives and intensifiers to persuade and give opinions with justification about food and drink</li> <li>Research skills; filling in a fact file in Spanish</li> <li>Understanding and answering questions in Spanish; spontaneous speech</li> </ul>
