

Wildlife Digital Photo Contest (March 3rd, 2014)

1. The photo contest is for all students.
2. The subject of the photo should be any native wildlife (birds, iguana, skinks, plants, etc.) in TCI.
3. The photo should be taken any day between January 14th and March 3rd, 2014 using any digital camera. (Set the date and time of your camera before shooting.)
4. One student is entitled to submit one entry. There is no limit for the number of entries per school.
5. Photographs must be in digital format. Only online entries will be eligible. No print or film submissions will be accepted.
6. All digital files must be 5 megabytes or smaller, must be in JPEG or JPG format, and must be at least 1,600 pixels.
7. Only minor color correction and cropping are allowed. High dynamic range images (HDR) and stitched panoramas are NOT acceptable.
8. Any changes to the original Photograph are unacceptable and will render the Photograph ineligible.
9. The digital file should be received by the DEMA nol later than 4:00 PM on March 3rd, 2014. Send your entries to both dema.tci@gmail.com & environment@gov.tc
10. Winning photos will be displayed at the National Environmental Centre (NEC), posted/uploaded oin the DEMA Website, or may be published in local newspapers.
11. The entry should be accompanied by a file indicating the name of the photographer (student), year/grade, name of the school, school Tel/FAX number, and email address of the school or the teacher in-charge/class advisor.
12. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the contest or modify these rules at its discretion.
13. **Any entry that violates the above guidelines will be disqualified.**
14. Prizes will be awarded during the Science Fair in March 2014.
