

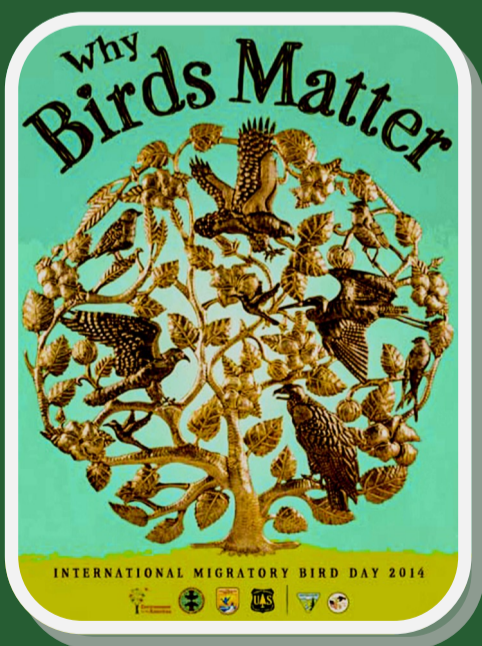
2014 International World Migratory Bird Day Why Birds Matter

Migratory bird Photo Contest:

1. The photo contest is for primary and high schools & adults. (over 18 years)
2. The subject of the photo should be migratory birds taken in TCI.
3. The photo should be taken any day between Oct. 1 to 31, 2014 using any digital camera.
4. One photo per entry.
5. Photographs must be in digital format. All digital files must be 5 megabytes or smaller, must be in JPEG or JPG format.
6. Only minor color correction and cropping are allowed.
7. Any changes to the original Photograph are unacceptable and will render the Photograph ineligible.
8. The digital file should be received by the DEMA not later than 4:00 PM on 31 October 2014. Send your entries to avenant.amy@gmail.com
10. Winning photos will be displayed at the National Environmental Centre (NEC), posted/uploaded in the DEMA Website or may be published in local newspapers.
11. The entry should be accompanied by a file indicating the name of the photographer (student), Year/Grade, and name of school, school Tel/FAX number, email address of the school or the teacher in-charge/Class Adviser. For adults entry, name and contact information.
12. Any entry that violates the above guidelines will be disqualified.

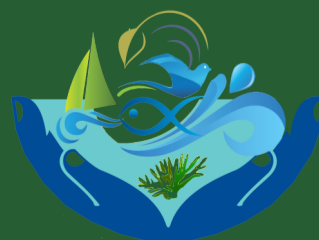
