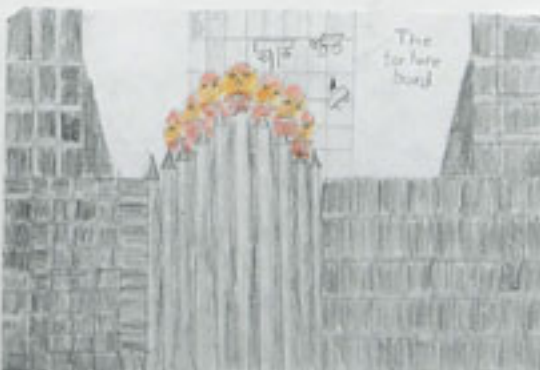

Parliament on the 5th of November.



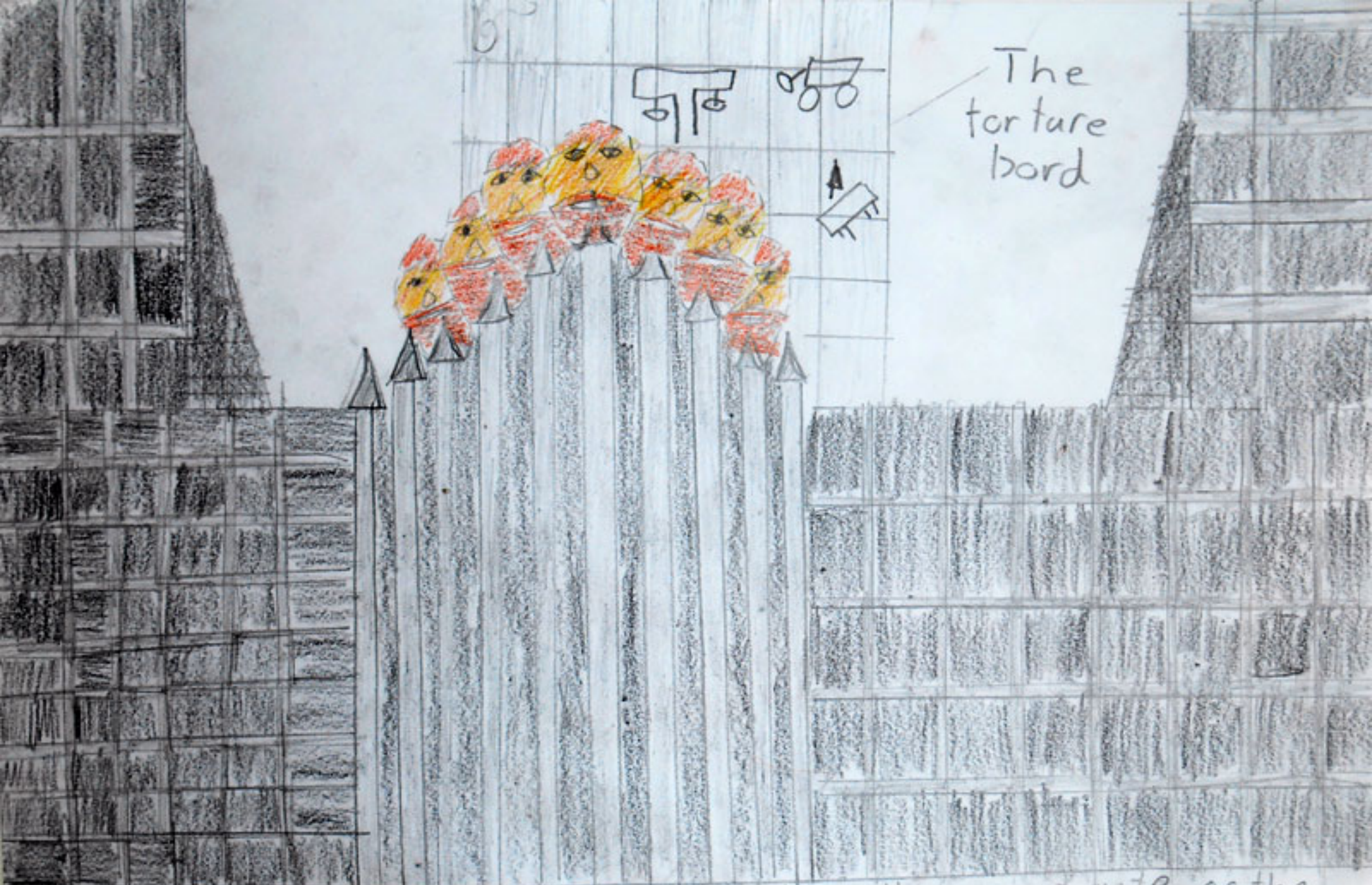
Guy Fawkes was seen red handed, with a dark lamp and a lit match, but it was not his fault because he was sent down there.
