
Water bottles:

General reminders:



PE will continue to take place on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** mornings. Children should come to school in their PE kits and change after the lesson. Please ensure that your child brings their water bottle and hat on these days.

Homework: After a stop-start term of homework, I hope to make the routines at little easier for the children (and myself!). All homework will be set on a Thursday and is due the following Wednesday. This includes weekly Maths, Topic and Spellings homework. Guided Reading homework will continue to be set after I have read with a group and should be returned a week after issue.

Curriculum and Topic information:

Topics this term: Flamingo class will be exploring two new topics this term. We will be learning lots about **Moving and Growing** in the first half term. In this science-based topic, children will discover how the skeletal and muscular systems work in humans and animals. After the mid term break, your child will become junior archaeologists, as we try to uncover the history of **Ancient Rome**. The children will consider how we can find out about the past by looking at what has survived from ancient civilisations. As before, our Art & Design, Literacy, Science and Social Studies will be taught through these topics. I will send home a full curriculum map for each topic, with specific details of how each subject will be taught.

Reading: Please ensure that your child's reading book comes into school each day, whether they are reading from the library or enjoying books from home. I've been extremely impressed with all of the Guided Reading homework, which has produced some creative and thoughtful responses. These questions are intended to be thought provoking and often ask for evidence from the text to justify an answer. These skills will become increasingly important as your child moves through school.

Parent volunteers: I have appreciated the support many parents over the Autumn term, both in-class and with our trip. During the Spring and Summer terms, we will be undertaking a number of educational visits to support our learning. We require a small number of parents to assist with transportation and supervision on these days. Please keep an eye out for information on these trips and I thank you in advance for
