<u>Curriculum and Topic Information</u>: In the Hummingbird class, all topics are designed to encourage creativity, curiosity and a love of learning. By focusing learning on one topic area, children are able to apply newly acquired skills in a meaningful way across the curriculum.

Our first topic this year is Journeys.

In this topic we will be learning all about how to travel to and from Provo, which countries we have visited, which countries we would like to visit, weather in those countries and what we would pack in our suitcase when we visit those countries.

<u>Homework</u>: In Year 1, reading is so important and so much fun that we will be sending home books for you to share with your child. These will be sent home from Monday 12th. September after an initial assessment of your child's reading.

Look out for the information regarding the Year 1 Reading Meeting that will take place before half term.

Year 1 homework may also consist of Literacy activities such as learning spellings, Numeracy activities and /or topic activities or games. No more than 20 minutes should be spent on any of these activities, although they can be repeated if your child is motivated to do so.

Whether helping with special events, educational visits or on a regular basis in class, your input is of great benefit to the children.
