Here's to another great term together!

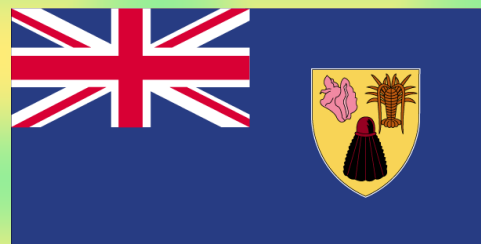
