Reading in Flamingo Class:

Developing reading for all purposes is a key objective in Year 4. We hope to support and inspire your child to become an engaged, independent reader in a number of ways.

Home/School Reading: Children will select a levelled book from the library to read at home and school. This should be changed regularly and reading will be monitored in class. Listening to and reading with your child is still highly relevant and valuable.

Guided Reading: is taught in small groups, where all children share a book together. Homework will be assigned from the text that is aimed at developing a range of skills and reading strategies.

Non-fiction: children are encouraged to read anything that interests them! Whether it be non-fiction, comics, magazines or online news/blogs...it is all highly valuable. Please feel free to share any such reading with us in class!

Curriculum and Topic information:

HOMEWORK: Homework in Flamingo Class comprises *spellings*, *numeracy* and *literacy/topic* activities — all of which will reinforce classroom teaching. Spellings are set every Monday and are tested the following Monday. All other homework is set on a Thursday and should be returned on the following Wednesday. This should allow your child the opportunity to plan when it is completed around out of school activities. In addition, children will receive *guided reading* homework — instructions for the return of this work will be recorded in their Guided Reading homework book.

TOPIC WORK: In Flamingo Class, we will be approaching our topics through a 'creative curriculum'. By centring learning around one topic area, children are able to apply their skills in a meaningful and purposeful way across the entire curriculum in a variety of ways. Children will learn to adopt a multi-disciplined approach to their work in order to research, investigate, reason and inquire.

Our first topic this year is **World Exploration**. A curriculum map will be shared soon to give you a sense of how the topic will be taught. You may find it useful to help support your child at home with reading material, movies and visits of interest! **PE:** This half term, we will be focussing on Athletics, ready for our Sports Day on Thursday 20th October. Children should come dressed for PE on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** mornings.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS: I greatly appreciate any support that parents are able to offer the class throughout the year. Whether helping with specific events and educational visits, or on a regular basis in class, your input is of huge benefit to the children. If you are able to offer your time in any way, please come to see me in class. I'll be delighted to make the most of your support!
