I have set out some of the regular reminders below. Topic Maps and related parts of the curriculum from each subject that will be covered this term will follow later, alongside the Curriculum Booklets that will share a more detailed outline of school procedures and parts of the Year 3 curriculum.

WATER: Please make sure your child has plenty of water, especially on days when we have PE.

SNACKS AND LUNCHES: Please ensure your child brings in a **healthy** snack/lunch to school every day *and remind them that we cannot be sharing or exchanging food with each other due to the growing amount of children with allergies.* Plus **PLEASE** NO chocolate bars or candies/sweets. School lunches begin week of the 12th and should be ordered at the office in advance.

UNIFORM: Children must wear appropriate school and PE uniforms, including a hat and sensible shoes. **NO JEWELLERY** to be worn please!

PE: According to the time table at the moment the children have PE on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays**. Please ensure your child arrives at school on those days in their PE kit, with their uniform to change into afterwards, **and LOTS of water!**

Mrs. Niki and Ms. Shara will be teaching **Theatre and Arts** this term. We will also be having 'one long and two shorter sessions' of **Spanish** on a weekly basis, taught by Miss Cara and Miss Yorke.

PUNCTUALITY: Children need to be in school for 8:15am and picked up at 3:00pm. Promptness is appreciated.
