## General Reminders

### Uniform

Please help Year 1 be the smartest class in school by making sure your child is wearing the proper school uniform, including appropriate footwear.

**P.E.** Our P.E. days are **Monday** and **Thursday** mornings. Your child will need to **come to school in their P.E. kit** and **bring their uniform in a bag** to change into on these days. P.E. kit consists of a white Provo Primary P.E. T-shirt, a pair of blue sports shorts and a pair of running shoes. The correct shoes are very important as we will be working in the Graceway Sports Centre on both P.E. days. The flooring in the centre requires the correct type of footwear to ensure your child's safety.

**Please note that if your child is late for school on a P.E. day you must bring your child to the office as the class may have gone to the Sports Centre and the classroom will be empty.**

## What's Happening from the Hummingbird News Desk!

Curriculum and Topic Information: In the Hummingbird class, all topics are designed to encourage creativity, curiosity and a love of learning. By focusing learning on one topic area, children are able to apply newly acquired skills in a meaningful way across the curriculum.

Our topic this term is **Architects and Engineers.**

This topic is inspired by two fantastic books called **Iggy Peck, Architect** and **Rosie Revere, Engineer**. In this topic we will be learning all about buildings, bridges and the materials used in their construction. We will have fun learning to design, plan and build a variety of structures. We will learn about important buildings and structures from around the world.

To help you support your child at home, you will find more detailed curriculum and timetable information in the Parent Information Booklet and the Year 1 Topic Map for this term.

Homework : In Year 1, **reading** is so important and so much fun. I will continue to send home books for you to share with your child. These will be changed on **Monday, Wednesday and Friday** each week. Please try to encourage your child to bring in their books on these days so that they can read the maximum amount of books available to them. This continuity will help your child to become the best reader that they can be. This term, Year 1 homework will also consist of weekly spellings to learn and a Math's activity that reinforces the work being carried out in class that week. No more than 20 minutes should be spent on these activities unless your child wishes to continue.
