The usual reminders are set out below:

PE: We will continue to have PE on a **Tuesday** and a **Thursday**. Please ensure your child arrives at school on those days in their PE kit, with their <u>uniform to change</u> into afterwards, and LOTS of water! If your child is arriving late for P.E. please make sure you drop them off either at the office or with a teacher at the place of where P.E. is taking place. They are **NOT** to walk alone or just be 'dropped' off without an adult being notified of their arrival – thank you.

HOMEWORK: The green Homework Book will continue to be given out on <u>Tuesday</u>, to be completed by the following <u>Monday</u> (latest). Spellings Homework will also continue to be given out on <u>Thursday</u> to be handed in by the following <u>Wednesday</u> (latest).

YELLOW HOME-SCHOOL READING BOOK — Please continue to listen to your children read regularly, and do sign or comment inside this book at least once a week; the children really appreciate your input. Do remember, any questions, concerns or ideas, do come and see me.
