## Literacy

- Core text The Silver Sword —
  exploration of main characters, draw on
  the historical context of the time, main
  themes, plots, characterisation,
  suspense and tension;
- Historical fiction stories which draw on true events, concentration camps, main players, evacuation and evacuees;
- Focusing on audience and purpose in our writing;
- Showing conscious control in our writing – making deliberate choices to impact the reader.

### Numeracy

- Ordering key dates on a timeline in chronological order;
- Examining numerical data through the use of a Spread Sheet linked to the time period – how many evacuees, how many soldiers, how many died in the Holocaust etc.

## Geography

- Exploring the world map and identify countries involved in war – Axis Powers and The Allies;
- Comparing Europe then and now and identify major changes – greater union to allow for trade etc;
- Identifying the countries impacted by WW2

## Computing

- Using appropriate search engines to record information on key World War 2 figures;
- Analysing Spread Sheets to explore statistics linked to war;
- Using Multimedia (PowerPoint, Prezi, Photography, Video & other suitable Apps) to present information linked to independent research;
- Becoming more aware of E-safety with a focus on cyber bullying.
